Emigrate | E+migr+ate

Moving out of a place

E = out

Migr = move

ate = state of or quality of (making it a verb)

Refugee | Re+fug+ee

A person who has run away or fleeing from danger, like war or genocide.

Re = Again

Fug = run or flee

ee = one who flees

Persecution = Per+secu+tion

A group that follows through to hurt you for holding a belief, such as religion or view.

Per = through

secu = follow (hostility)

tion = An act on someone

Sending money to your family

re = Again

Mitt = Send

Ances = indicating action

An area under rule

Reg = Rule

Ion = condition

Genocíde | Geno+cíde

Organized elimination or killing of a group of humans

Geno = Human

Cíde = killing
